

FACTS & HISTORY OF MAURITIUS















Mauritius is an island of 1865 km2 with 330 km of coastline and beaches

Currently, the population is about 1,400,000

The Portuguese first visited the island in 1510. After the island has been occupied by the Dutch in the 16s, by the French in the

17s and finally by the British in 1810 till its independence.

Independence & Republic: Mauritius achieved independence on 12 March 1968 and changed its status to Republic on 12 March 1992

Language spoken: English (official language), French (commonly spoken) and Creole

Climate: Temperature during warm humid summer (November to April) varies from 30 to 35 degrees celsius, and winter (June to September) from 20 to 25 degrees celsius

Food: Beyond the established Creole Food, restaurants offer international, Indian & Chinese food. Some places specialized in Italian, Japanese & French cuisine

Currency: Mauritian Rupees (MUR)

Health: There are public hospitals & private clinics (Paid) though our Hotel proposes its own medical service.

Dress code: When visiting any places in Mauritius, we propose you to seek advice from our Concierge Team

Le Caudan Waterfront

Opening Hours: Mon - Sat (9:30 - 17:00) On Sundays (9:30 - 12:00) Located on the Docks of Port-Louis, it is one of the oldest malls of Mauritius. It includes boutiques, duty- free shops, cheap food vendors, live music & a food court. It also hosts some events such as bazar sales, where home-made goods are sold.

Blue Penny Museum

Opening Hours: Mon - Sat (9:30 - 17:00) Dedicated to the world famous stamps 1847, the Blue $\,$

Penny allows you to peak into the past and present day look of Port - Louis.

Natural History Museum

Opening Hours: Mon - Fri (9:00 - 12:00) Closed on Sundays & Public Holidays

Located on the ground floor of the Mauritius Institute, this museum was built around 1880.

The oldest museum of Mauritius is divided into: Fauna Gallery, Marine Life Gallery, Insects, Meteorology, Giant Tortoise Gallery & The World of the Dodo

Aapravasi Ghat

Opening hours: Mon - Fri (9:30 - 16:30) - Saturday (9:00 -12:00) Closed on Sundays UNESCO World Heritage - Located on the bay of Trou Fanfaron, in the capital of Port - Louis, the Aapravasi Ghat is the remains of an immigration depot, the site from where modern indentured labour emerged.



Postal Museum

opening Hours: Mon - Fri (09:30 - 16:30) Saturday & Public Holidays: (9:30 - 15:30) The Mauritius Postal Museum invites you to discover the major events that marked the history of the postal services in Mauritius



Citadel (Fort Adelaide)

Named after the Queen Adelaide, the fort has been built between 1834 & 1840, under the direction of William IV. Fort Adelaide, also known as 'La Citadelle' has fulfilled the strategic purpose of guarding the harbour against enemy attacks and fires that broke in the city.

Aventure Du Sucre

Opening Hours: Mon - Sat (including public Holidays) 9:00 - 17:00

The setting of this museum is an old factory and tells the fascinating story of sugar industry in Mauritius. It lies within the beautiful Beau Plan Sugar Estate, located close to the Pamplemousses Botanical Gardens.

Pamplemousses (SSR) Botanical Garden

Opening Hours: The Sir Seewoosagur Ramgoolam Botanic Garden is

one of the oldest in the Southern Hemisphere. It dates to the French period in 1736. Among the various vegetable, fruits and flowers imported from around the world, the garden holds some of the most prized species of the time.

Cap Malheureux

Cap Malheureux is a village in Mauritius Located in Rivière du Rempart District. The place Cap Malheureux was named so after the defeat of the French against the English.

Cap Malheureux is quite famous and iconic for the scene and the fishermen's church found in the village. The church with the red roof, the 'Notre Dame Auxiliatrice'. (Roman Catholic Church)
